TIPS

- Determine type of job you want to pursue
- Take GRE test/improve scores if needed
- Secure advisor and funding
- Get admitted to graduate program



NON-THESIS

- Opportunity to work more closely and frequently with professionals in the field
- Can take less time to complete
- Often mirrors a bachelor's program in terms of structure
- Some programs offer online options

THESIS

- Research focused
- Completing a thesis shows prospective schools and employers that you possess the skills needed for researching and writing long-form reports
- · Possibility of publication
- Helpful for those pursuing PhD

PhD

- Research focused
- Involves devoting several years to intense research on a single research area
- Often required coursework is minimal to allow for a selfdesigned plan of study tailored to support the research project
- · Expectation of publishing
